MD, graduate at the Faculty of Medicine of the National University of Mexico (UNAM) in 1966. Specialist in General Surgery, in the General Hospital of Mexico City, 1967-1968, being one of the initial members of the General Surgery board. Tutelar formation in History and Philosophy of Medicine with Francisco Fernández del Castillo, Head of the History and Philosophy of Medicine Department at the UNAM from 1967 to 1972, being after that his assistant and joint professor until 1983. PhD in History of Biological Sciences, at the Metropolitan University of Mexico. Theses: “La configuración de la medicina novohispana. 1521-1620.” (The Configuration of New Spain Medicine. 1521-1620). Actually is full time professor at the Department of History and Philosophy of Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, UNAM and Coordinator of PHD studies in History of Medicine and Health Sciences and Bioethics (Medical humanities), at the Postgraduate Division (UNAM). From 1983 to 2012 he was Director of the Department of History and Philosophy of Medicine, Faculty of Medicine (UNAM). He is author or editor of some 50 books, among them “México Antiguo”, first volume of Historia General de la Medicina en México (1985), being also director of this work with two more volumes published and one more in press; “La medicina prehispánica de México” (1985), “Ticótl. Conceptos médicos de los antiguos mexicanos” (1997), seven volumes on the History of Medicine in Mexico (2006-2013) in bilingual, Spanish and English, edition; six volumes on

the History of Medicine in the Estado de México (2007-2012), also in bilingual edition; “Temas de “Historia de la Medicina en México” (2007); four volumes on the medical thinking at the National Academy of Medicine of Mexico in the last 150 years (2014-2015). Also he have published around a hundred chapters in books and some two hundred papers in Mexican and international journals.

He is actually vicepresident of the International Society for the History of Medicine, and has been previously national delegate for Mexico, and participated in congresses and academic activities of the ISHM from the London Congress in 1970. He has been President of the Mexican Society of History and Philosophy of Medicine and member of the Academia Nacional de Medicina (México), Academia Mexicana de Cirugía, Academia Mexicana de Ciencias, Academia Nacional Mexicana de Bioética, Real Academia de Medicina de Catalunya, Academia Italiana di Storia dell'arte Sanitaria, Academia and Sociedad Argentinas de Historia de la Medicina, Sociedad Chilena de Historia de la Medicina. Titular of the Académie Internationale de Philosophie de la Science.
